- **Accountability** - School Climate Surveys are now open, the survey window is February 27, 2023, through April 14, 2023. All students in grades 3 through 12 complete the student survey. Results of the student and teacher surveys will be used to calculate a School Climate indicator for use in each school's report card rating. The student and teacher surveys will be administered through the eCollect system within PowerSchool to be completed through the Student Portal or Teacher Portal. The parent survey will be administered through Qualtrics. Parents can access this through the Parent Portal.
