

Advocacy is critical for strong policies at the state and local levels. Electing education champions who will put kids first, keep students at the center of their policy priorities, and follow through to ensure new policies are effectively implemented shapes the conditions of our children's and our communities' futures.

Messaging that matters:

- Educate others! Charter schools are free, public, and open to all!
- Know and share your school's unique mission and vision.
- Describe how your school meets the individual needs of students
- Celebrate the passionate teachers serving children in their classrooms.
- Communicate your role in ensuring the school is held accountable.

Be an Advocate:

- Follow your charter school on social media and consider celebrating your school on your social media platforms.
- Post about your "why" and your volunteer experience on the board.
- Ask your board to talk about the board's role in advocacy and set advocacy goals.
- Participate in advocacy events and encourage your peers to do the same.
- Invite community and business leaders to visit your school or to school events.
- Work with PCSD to connect with your legislators and tell them your charter's story.
